

Potential Manager Earnings

Personally Hold Parties and Build a Unit that Holds Parties

You holding ONE standard party/week

$\$600 \times 4 \text{ weeks} = \$2,400 \times .25 = \$600$

Personal Sales Volume Bonus

= \$ 600 Personal Profit

= \$ 100 PSVB

5 standard unit parties a month

$5 \times \$600 = \$3,000 \text{ (unit Sales)} + \$2,400 \text{ (personal sales)} = \$5,400$

$\$5,400 \times .75 = \$4,050 \times .02 = \$81$

$\$5,400 \text{ unit retail sales (V2 bonus) (based on retail sales 3 levels deep)}$

= \$ 81 Profit Plus

= \$ 70 Vanguard Bonus

Totals = \$ 851 Potential Earnings

You holding TWO standard parties/week

$\$600 \times 2 = \$1,200 \times 4 \text{ weeks} = \$4,800 \times .25 = \$1,200$

Personal Sales Volume Bonus*

= \$ 1,200 Personal Profit

= \$ 300 PSVB

5 standard unit parties a month

$5 \times \$600 = \$3,000 \text{ (unit Sales)} + \$4,800 \text{ (personal sales)} = \$7,800$

Profit Plus $\$7,800 \times .75 = \$5,850 \times .02 = \$117$

$7,800 \text{ unit retail sales (V2 bonus) (based on retail sales 3 levels deep)}$

= \$ 117 Profit Plus

= \$ 90 Vanguard Bonus

Totals = \$ 1707 Potential Earnings

Unit Structure

To become a Manager, you need 3 or more active, personally recruited level 1 unit members.

In this structure, you can also have Managers at any one of these levels.

If someone below you fully leaves the business (inactive closed) anyone they recruited will move up a level. This is referred to as compression.
