

## **HAVE YOU CONSIDERED THESE FACTS?**

The average woman's wage is based on a 5-day week, 8 hours a day, 40 hours a week.

If she makes \$480.00 weekly (12.00/hr.), she would take home about \$360.00 after deductions.
