## Apricot Sorbet

### Serves 4

- 1 (15 oz.) can apricot halves
- 2 tbsp. sugar
- ½ lemon, juiced

Place apricot halves and juice in 2 ¾-cup/650 mL Small 2 **Freezer Mates**® container. Place in freezer and freeze until solid. Remove from freezer and break into medium chunks and place in **Quick Chef** with blade attachment. Add sugar and lemon juice. Replace cover and turn handle and process until smooth. Place back into a **Freezer Mates**® container and store in freezer until serving. Allow to soften slightly before serving.



## Creamy Orange Dreamsicle

### Serves 4

- 1 cup heavy cream
- ½ cup sugar
- 2 oranges (juice and zest)
- Pinch of salt
- Whip cream, sugar, orange juice and salt to soft peaks in **Quick Chef** with paddle attachment.
- Place into 2 ¾-cup/650 mL Small 2 **Freezer Mates**® container to harden and store in freezer until serving. Allow to soften slightly before serving.

*Note: May substitute strawberries, blueberries or mixed berries for oranges.*
